

LEA Organizational Structure: Special Education December 22, 2023

In Maryland, where does special education reside within each LEA's organizational structure?

In the organizational structure of 21 LEAs, special education falls under the same division as general education division (i.e., academics, curriculum and instruction, teaching and learning, etc.).



Special education resides with general education in 87% of LEAs (N=21) and outside general education in 18% of LEAs (N=3). The LEAs with special education separate from general education are Kent, Washington, and Wicomico.
